

CCRC Child Care Assistance Guide

Families approved for CCRC assistance may choose **any licensed provider** who accepts subsidy.
Parkside Daycare is here to support your family through the process.

1. Eligibility

To qualify for CCRC assistance, families must meet both income and need requirements.

- **Income:** Your household income must fall within the state's income ceiling for your family size.
- **Need for Care:** You must be working, in school or training, actively looking for work, experiencing homelessness, or receiving CPS-related services. CCRC uses these two factors to determine whether your family qualifies for subsidized child care.

2. Join the CCRC Eligibility List

If you're not already in CalWORKs Stage 1, you begin by joining the Eligibility List.

- Complete the online intake form on the CCRC website.
- Provide basic information about your family, income, and child care needs.
- Your place on the list is based on income and need level. CCRC will contact you when funding becomes available for your family.

3. Respond When Contacted

When your name reaches the top of the list, CCRC will reach out by phone, email, or mail. You'll receive:

- A case manager
- Instructions
- Required forms
- A personalized document checklist Responding quickly helps prevent delays or your spot being skipped.

4. Gather Required Documents

Your case manager will tell you exactly what to submit, but most families need:

- **Identity:** Parent ID and child's birth certificate
- **Income:** Recent pay stubs, tax return (if self-employed), or benefits letters
- **Need for Care:** Work schedule, school schedule, or job search documentation
- **Residence:** Lease, utility bill, or other proof of address

5. Enrollment Appointment

- You will meet with your CCRC case manager by phone, virtual meeting, or in person. The case manager will review all documents you submitted.
- They may ask clarifying questions about your work or school schedule.
- They will determine your approved hours (full-time, part-time, or variable) and explain any family fees that may apply based on your income.
- They will confirm your child's authorized start date.

6. Tell CCRC Your Provider Choice

- Inform your case manager that you are choosing Parkside Daycare.
- ★ CCRC will request a copy of the license and rate sheet (see below), and our EIN is available by request.
- CCRC will send an official authorization notice to both you and Parkside with your approved schedule, start date, and payment details.
- Once authorization is issued, your child may begin attending.

7. Attendance

- Attendance is record and submitted to monthly to CCRC.

8. Recertification

- Every 12 months, CCRC must verify that your family still qualifies for assistance.
- Submitting recertification documents on time prevents any interruption in your child care authorization.

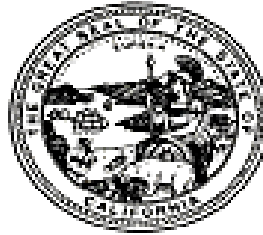
